

Riding Mountain Transit

Finding your bus stop and bus

Mountain Transit buses pickup and drop off passengers only at designated bus stops.

Arrive at your stop 5 minutes before the scheduled departure time.

Route numbers are displayed on the top-front, and passenger-side window of the bus. If in doubt, just ask the driver.



Realtime Arrival Info

Download the Doublemap app to see exactly where your bus is and when it will arrive. Select "Mountain Transit" as your system to see nearby route options and departures.

Getting on and off the bus

Have your fare or pass ready before boarding. If paying with cash, make sure to have the exact amount, as bus drivers do not make change.

When you are ready to get off the bus, pull the bell cord or tell the driver in advance of your stop.

Bikes on buses

All Mountain Transit buses are equipped with bike racks which hold two bicycles. They are available on a first come-first served basis.



Accessibility

All Mountain Transit vehicles are wheelchair accessible.



For persons unable to use the fixed route bus service, Mountain Transit also offers Dial-a-Ride service. Call or visit mountaintransit.org for details.

Holiday Service

Mountain Transit regular routes, Off the Mountain, and Dial-a-Ride service do not operate on:

New Year's Day, 4th of July, Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day.

Sunday service is operated on:

MLK Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Veterans's Day and Labor Day.

Rules to Ride By

- No eating, drinking, smoking or vaping on the buses.
- Seatbelt use is required.
- No more items than passenger can carry on at one time and place under seat or in lap (limit 4).
- Animals in approved pet carrier only. Passengers are limited to two pet carriers.
- No hazardous materials on bus.
- Music may be played only through headphones.
- Use of profane language, harassment of the operator or other passengers will not be tolerated.
- Personal hygiene must not affect other customers
- Passengers who fail to comply with these rules may be denied service and/or discharged from the bus.

Información en español

- Los autobuses recogen pasajeros unicamente en las ubicaciones aprobadas.
- Se requiere el uso del cinturón de seguridad.
- Esté en la parada 5 minutos antes de la horade salida que figura en el horario.
- No está permitido comer, beber ni fumar en los autobuses.
- No esté permitido llevar más bolsos de los que pueda cargar un pasajero, y los mismos deban colocarse debajo delasiento on en la faldo (límite de 4 bolsos).
- Solo se permiten animales en jaulas o cajas aprobadas.
- No se permiten materiales peligrosos en el autobús.
- No se permiten radios ni reproductores de música sin auriculares.
- La higiene personal no debe afectar a otros clientes
- No se permiten lenguaje ni comportamientos ofensivos o inapropiados.
- Los pasajeros que no cumplan con estas reglas se les puede negar el servicio o pueden ser retirados del autobús.
- Tenga su tarifa listo antes de subir. Si paga con dinero en efectivo, asegúrese de tener la cantidad exacta, ya que los conductores de autobús no tienen cambio.

Mountain Transit accepts VVTA, Omnitrans and Metrolink tickets/passes for \$1.00 (general) or \$.50 (Senior/disabled/veteran) dicount on your cash fare only.

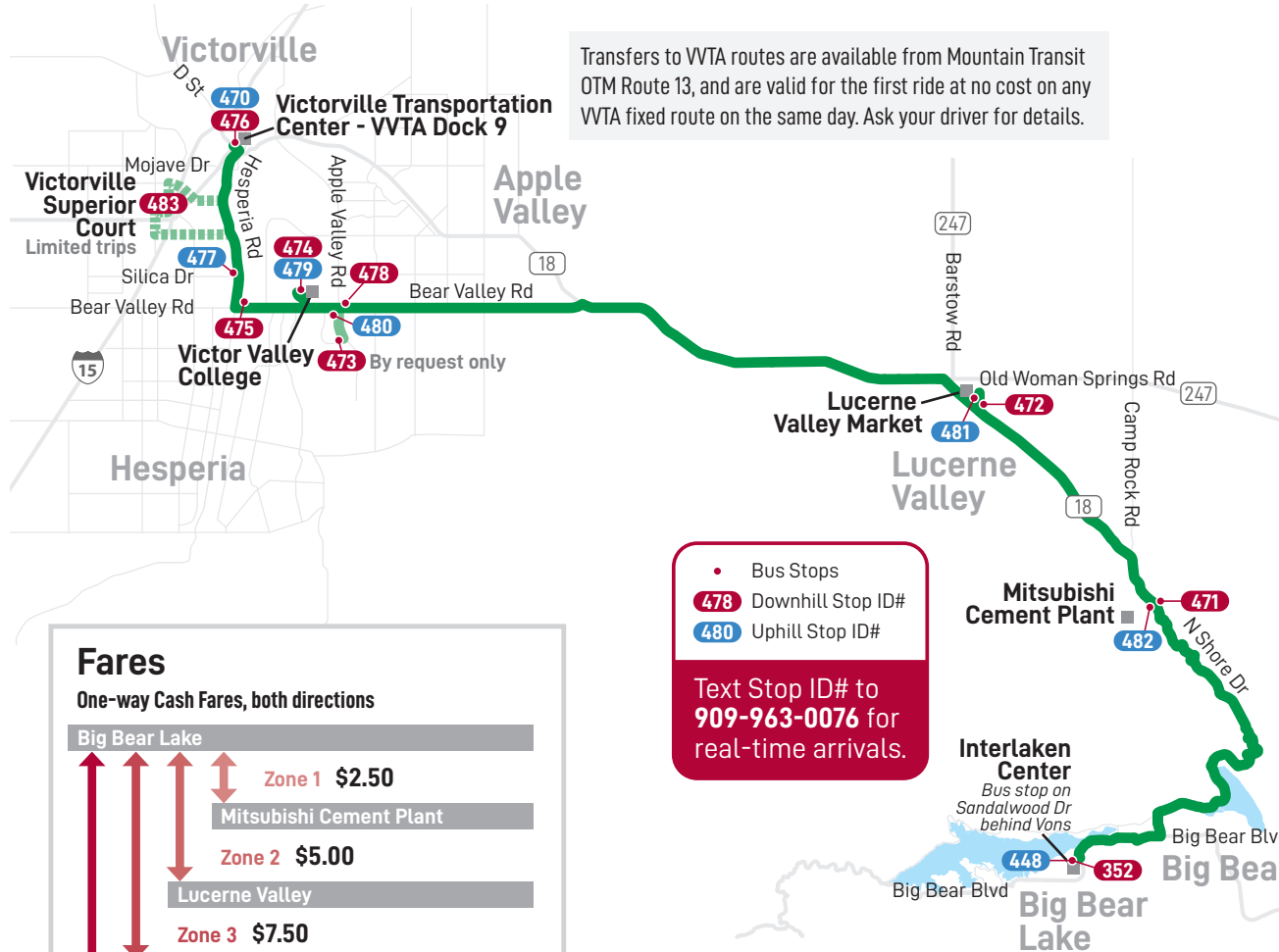

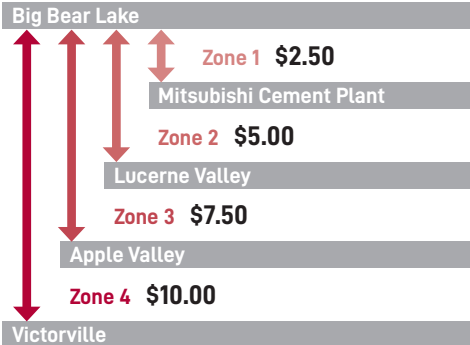
